During a job interview, it's usual for the interviewers to ask about your weak points. For example, they might say "Tell me your three weakest points." or "What weak points do you think you have as a worker?" They want to see how you react, test how honest you are, and check if you have the ability to be true to yourself.

Avoid giving such answers as “I’m too organized”, “I work too much”, or “I’m too much of a perfectionist”.

If they ask you about your weak points, answer honestly. Try not to turn them around and present them as strengths. If you do, the interviewers may think you're not telling the truth and are hiding your weak points.

Nobody's perfect. We all have flaws, areas in which we could improve. Try to answer the questions that the interviewers ask you instead of saying what you want them to hear.

Respond wisely. It means thinking before speaking. Don't rush when you talk about your weak points. Think for a little while before you share your observations (观察) and considerations.

When you talk about your weak points, briefly explain when they tend to happen and what you're doing to improve them. This isn't an easy task because your weak points often form a pattern of behavior that's developed over time. Therefore, it also takes time to realize this and change it. But, you can show that you have realized these weak points and that you are trying to improve them.
